Main Street Board Walk around 5/8/2025

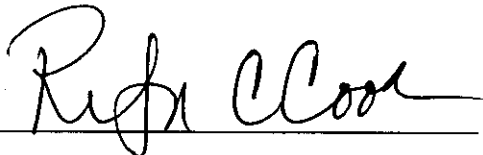
- Wheelchair access all around
- Handicap parking around square

- Take care of plants and weeds on sidewalks and curbs
 1. Spray for weeds and pull them
- Take care of dead vines by Hearsay Wine bar Alley
- Add benches with backs around square
- Signs for no shipping trucks through downtown
- In the small parking lot across from Hearsay Wine Bar, add public restrooms, make it a green space
- Add lights in alley by Hearsay
- Take care of the Hole from poles in front of Heath Allen
- Take care of flower bed in front of the collective- cover with brick
- No street signs on Belknap and Washington (anywhere)
- Repaint Yellow/red on curbs
- Old light stop Belknap and Washington-concrete base still there (remove)
- Add stop sign 4 way College and Graham
- Hole on Washington street next to King Coffee
 1. TXDOT/Public Works
- Bollards by Cross Timbers Title (keep from driving on curbs)
- More planters throughout downtown
- Purchase a Street Sweeper or leaf gatherer
- Sidewalks to repair
