Mayor Svien called the Regular Meeting to order at 05:32 PM.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

1. Consider Rescinding the Award to Purchase a Patrol SUV from Bruner Motors and Award to Donohoo Chevrolet

Committee Chair David Baskett presented this item to the Council.

Bids were solicited and opened on February 21, 2025, for the purchase of (1) patrol SUV. Three responses were received. The lowest bid was submitted by Donohoo Chevrolet for \$52,100; however, under Section 271.905 of the Local Government Code concerning Local Vendor Preference, Bruner Motors was awarded the contract for \$53,795. The bid submitted by Bruner Motors in February indicated a delivery time of 24 weeks; however, Bruner Motors has since confirmed that they are unable to meet the originally specified

delivery time. Additional discussions have raised concerns regarding the feasibility of delivering the item within the next year or within any expected timeframe.

Donohoo Chevrolet has confirmed the same 2025 Chevy Tahoe PPD can be provided, honoring the same price they submitted for ITB 3339. The unit will be delivered within 10 days after receipt of a purchase order.

Donohoo Chevrolet submitted a bid of \$52,100 for a 2025 Chevy Tahoe. The item and price will be honored. The approved budget for 2024-2025 included \$55,000 for a Patrol SUV.

It is the recommendation of the Purchasing Department and Police Department to rescind the award to Bruner Motors for a Patrol SUV (ITB 3339) and award to Donohoo Chevrolet.

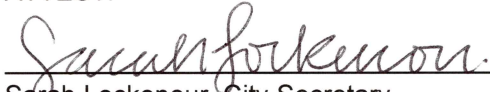
